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An Analytical Study of Educational and Social Values from the Point of View of the Administrative Bodies of the Central Federations in Iraq

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#### **ABSTRACT**

It has become imperative for us to protect our youth from negative changes by preserving the social and moral values and principles that are related to sports education. Herein lies the problem and importance of this study in measuring educational and social values as a means of identifying the mathematical community in Iraq, and the research aims to build a measure of educational and social values in the light of globalization, Analysis of educational and social values from the viewpoint of the central federations. After that, the two researchers process the results in the winning chapter to obtain the results of the research

#### INTRODUCTION

The educational and social values have become threatened through political interference in the work of the Olympic committees and local sports federations. These interventions will lead to the reluctance of many sports leaders to assume the responsibilities of movement in their countries due to the commitment sports different countries to work under local regulations and laws issued by these countries, especially Permanent change and little planning and their association with sport is functional and not scientific, and there is a large number of government employees who are ignorant of what sport seeks to achieve educational principles, values and ideals (Sallum, 2009). From aforementioned, it has become imperative for us to preserve our youth from negative changes by preserving social and moral values and principles that are related to physical education. Here lies the problem and the importance of this study in measuring educational and social values as a means of getting to know the sports community in Iraq. (Al-Mahdi, 2005), and what complicates the problem is the weakness of the educational values of sports on the levels vis-à-vis the strength hegemony enjoyed by Western societies, which led to the emergence of ethics that exceeded the noble goal of sports educational ethics, and since sport is an educational basis, it must be taken into account Respect and love for the people and the nation by developing a sense of belonging and identity and protecting our athletes from the manifestations of malicious globalization and its negative changes. Hence, the two researchers decided to delve into this problem and find an appropriate solution to it.

#### METHOD AND TOOLS

The descriptive approach was used in the survey method, being the most appropriate to the nature of the problem and the objectives of the research. The overall research community was identified, which reached (373) members with (25) Olympic federations (22)and non-Olympic federations. The two researchers excluded the Football Association because it is considered dissolved and an alternative As for the normalization body, as shown in Table 1, as for the research sample, it consisted of all members of community that the researcher mentioned above, with a percentage (100%) of the research community. The researcher divided the sample into (8) individuals for the survey sample, and (241) individuals for a building sample. The two scales, and (124) members for the application sample, as shown in Tables (1, 2)

After completing the idea with researchers stemming from reviewing the challenges facing the Olympic and non-Olympic federations and after conducting several interviews with the concerned parties and consulting and conducting many personal interviews Appendix (1) After defining the problem, it requires dealing with the use of the educational and social values scale in light of globalization, and why The scientific integrity fragmentation, as well as the use of a scale that would fit with the sample, the two researchers built the educational and social values scale in light of globalization, for the Olympic and non-Olympic federations.

Procedures for building the scale (educational and social values in light of globalization): The two researchers intended to design a questionnaire and follow the scientific foundations in producing it in the correct manner that reflects the sample level.

Defining the idea of scale (educational and social values in light of globalization): The idea of scale was defined by relying on many scientific sources, and the researchers were keen to

explain the idea of scale clearly and explicitly

Determining the goal of the scale (educational and social values in light of globalization): The goal of building the scale in any field was to search for a codified scientific method to identify the feature or phenomenon to be measured, which is mathematical globalization

Defining the theoretical framework for the scale (educational and social values in light of globalization): It is the reference that the researchers adopt to define the sub-fields of the scale and define each field

Preparing the paragraphs of the scale Educational and social values in light of globalization: The scale of educational and social values in light of globalization may consist of (43) paragraphs in its initial form, and this step is one of the basic pillars in designing the standards, and the

researchers used the method of choosing from five alternatives (Likert ) As a graded five-point scale was set (always, often, sometimes, rarely, at all) and the grading scale was arranged starting from (5) always (4) often (3) sometimes (2) rarely (1) never, for positive paragraphs 5-1 The negative sections 1-5 for the educational and social values scale because it contains this type of paragraphs. Determine the validity of paragraphs became the scale (34) paragraph out of (43), paragraph any have been neglected (9) paragraphs of Appendix (5) identify the scale of the educational and social values of the image initial and tables (5.4) shows the value of square like the two measures note that the value of significance to be Significant when < 0.05

experience to a group of (8) members of the Bodybuilding Federation at their workplace, and the sample's acceptance of the scale was demonstrated through the clarity of instructions, the ease of understanding and clarity of the

paragraphs The researcher or the assisting team did not encounter any negatives or obstacles.

# The main experiment in building a scale of educational and social values in light of globalization

After reaching the initial formula for the scale educational and social values in light of globalization, for the Olympic and non-Olympic federations, as the two researchers, with the help of the assistant

work team, used the electronic form in view of the current circumstances and for the two measures to reach the sample faster by applying the scale to the members of the building sample, who are (241) individuals From members of the Olympic and Non-Olympic federations, and after completing the implementation of the main experiment, the researchers arranged the questionnaire forms, corrected them, and recorded the results in preparation for their analysis.

It was found that most of the paragraphs of the educational values scale are statistically significant (significant) except for paragraphs (7 and 13), so they are not significant at the level of significance (0.05), so it was rejected.

#### **Stability:**

Halftone segmentation: It is a method for measuring the stability of the scale, and upon applying this method, the correlation coefficient of the mathematical globalization scale appeared (0.665) and this represents the correlation of half of the paragraphs, as the two researchers later found the reliability coefficient for the

scale using the Saber man Brown correlation coefficient, which shows its value (0.509), which is the value of stability High.

Fakronkach coefficient: When applying the mathematical globalization scale to the building sample, the stability coefficient is (0.776), which is a high value of stability. Objectivity: It was achieved by not interfering with the arbitrators in the process of correction and obtaining the final score for the scale; in addition to that, the researchers added two paragraphs with similar meaning in order to identify the objectivity of the answer to each question.

The main experience of applying the scale of educational and social values in light of globalization

After the construction process is completed and the scale is ready in its final form, it consists of (32) appendix () in the final form, and then the two questionnaires are distributed among the research sample of (124) members of the Olympic and Non-Olympic Federation, and the paragraphs are arranged in a manner .The questionnaires sequential were collected after a specified period, and were re-arranged in an orderly manner according to each field in preparation for submitting them to statistical treatments.

The researchers used the statistical bag methods SPSSTo treat the results using the following laws, descriptive statistics: (arithmetic mean, median, mode, standard deviation, torsion, highest and lowest degree).

- Authenticity coefficients: (discerning ability, inner consistency, Spearman Brown, Persen), (test t).
- Stability coefficients: (Alpha Cronbach), halves.
- Correlation coefficient (Pearson).

For the purpose of calculating the significance of the scale, the hypothetical mean of the scale was found by the equation.

#### RESULTS

Presenting and discussing the statistical description of the Educational and Social Values Scale and the Hypothesis Medium:

Table (7) displays the statistical description of the application sample data for the Educational and Social Values Scale, verifies the significance of the scale, and identifies the sample level through the hypothetical mean.

It is evidenced by the results of the test (T When making a comparison between the arithmetic and hypothetical mean of the scale, there are statistically significant differences in favor of the hypothetical mean, as the significant value reached (0.0000), which is smaller than the significance level (0.05), which indicates that the Iraqi Central Olympic and Non-Olympic federations have a poor level of values The educational and social impact the era of globalization, as the researcher believes that the globalization system has its negative effects and has led to the change of many educational and social values due to the negative pressures and effects caused by globalization more than it is positive, as everyone may agree on the extreme impact of mathematical globalization on the formation of the personality of the individual and his definition of himself, The importance of values for the individual and society is that the difficulty of preserving the educational and social values of these unions in the era of globalization is caused by dealing with

other societies. "Societies differ from each other with what they adopt of cultural assets and value standards. Therefore, preserving these values guarantees the preservation of the community's identity, which is also It leads to the erosion of his identity in the event that this value system of his own is disrupted...(Al- Jallad, 2007) that any social and educational behavior, in essence, is based on the principle of the system that governs the relations between the members of the federations in general and the one union in particular and is based on a pattern of values that they represent among them, and this in turn leads their cohesion and the achievement of the largest number of set goals as well as Cohesion and consistency in values preserves for them sound and stable administrative procedures. This is what the members of the federations lacked from the boldness of globalization dominated the course of this administrative and sports work, which includes players, coaches and administrators. Although educational and

social values are among the necessities of life and society cannot live without them, we cannot find In any place in the world, behavior groups of abandoned randomly or a plunder of chaos and unconditional freedom. The state of the meeting is in which the activities of individuals clash and their freedoms clash, and this contention and conflict cannot be left to circumstances, unless the unity of society is torn apart under the pressure of these conflicting tendencies and desires. This segment of society is in dire need of a system or system of values that acts as a guide for its behavior, energies and motives for its activity, and it is in need of social organization and value arrangement that includes its goals and the like. Alia, which forms the basis for the student's life, activities and relationships others" with (Mahdi, 2005) educational and social values in their entirety do not come from a vacuum, and that the values sources originate from or are available through and these sources of religious teachings that are the source of president of the many values and also the socialization that give the individual includes a set of values and knowledge specific Determine the individual's desired behavior in society, and for that the values must be emphasized" (Ashour, 1992) The researcher believes that the educational social values in the light of and

globalization are the ones that determine the federations 'pursuit of their existence and the building of a sports society based on general foundations and principles as well as their importance in the face of globalization and the enormous societal developments that affect in one way or another the sports community, which considers globalization as one of these changes Developments, therefore, members of the federations wanted a way to confront the problems and conflicts between all the joints concerned with sports. "The loss of values makes the individual floundering in random actions because he does not realize the importance of his actions. Values act as a guide for behavior and as a basis for him, which contribute to the formation individual's psychological entity and enable him to issue Judgments on practical practices that he performs" (Sallum, 2009) The educational values constitute the basic pillar in the formation of social relations and determine the nature of social interaction between individuals. Values prevailing among members of a society may help predict the course of social life in that society. Values represent the essence of social behavior that is based on the principle of the system that governs relations between members of society and that it has a prominent role in achieving

harmony and consistency between the individual and the surrounding society.

"Educational and social values occupy a great position in all scientific and life fields, especially the field of sports and its many forms, as it represents one of the general foundations for the processes of learning and human conditioning. The importance of educational and social values for athletes has emerged as one of the educational means used to achieve social cohesion, achievement and athletic excellence.

#### **CONC**LUSIONS

- The building of the educational and social values scale was reached according to (32) paragraphs.
- Understanding and ease of application of the two measures of globalization of mathematics and the educational and social values of the research sample.

- The difficulty of preserving educational and social values in light of globalization in the Olympic and Non-Olympic Central Federations.
- The presence of more than one party that interferes in one way or another to control sports or the sports community through the globalization of sports.

#### RECOMMENDATIONS

- The necessity of preserving educational and social values in light of the system of globalization and under economic and political pressures.
- Setting programs and training plans that work to educate unions and society about the globalization system of sports and educational and social values.
- Conducting other studies dealing with educational and social values and on other samples.
